Data Protection & Privacy Policy

South Downs Trojan Swimming Club are committed to protecting and respecting your privacy.

This policy sets out the basis on which any personal data we collect from you, or that you provide to us, will be processed by us. Please read the following carefully to understand our practices regarding your personal data and how South Downs Trojan Club will treat it.



For the purpose of the Data Protection Act 1998 (the Act), the Data Controller is the South Downs Trojan Swimming Club.

DATA PROTECTION REGISTRATION

We are a small, not for profit club, with a limited range of data processing activities. As such we are exempt from registration with the Information Commissioner's Office ("ICO"). Should this change, we will notify members and update our Privacy policy accordingly.

INFORMATION WE MAY COLLECT FROM YOU

We require this information in order to operate the club and provide the very best service to our members, including:

- Effective communication about upcoming events and changes to scheduled activities, such as the cancellation of training
- · Contacting next of kin in the event of emergencies
- Coaches being fully informed of medical conditions of members when training or away at events
- Internal record keeping, e.g. volunteer qualifications This includes information provided when:
- Registering for events
- · Subscribing for membership
- Posting material
- Entering a competition (which may include medical information about you which is collected purely for
 the purpose of ensuring your health and safety when competing and which will not be transferred to
 any third party save as specifically authorised by you or in a medical emergency)
- · Reporting a problem
- Providing payment details
- Emergency contact details
- Relevant medical information about the swimmer, volunteer or workforce
- Information about any relevant impairments that the swimmer or volunteer may have
- Details of transactions you carry out through us and of the fulfilment of any orders or requirements

If you believe that information is being held about yourself without legitimate grounds, then you have the right to request this data to be deleted. Please do so by emailing the address below.

USES MADE OF THE INFORMATION

We use information held about you in the following ways:

- To provide you with information, or services that you request from us or which we feel may interest you, where you have consented to be contacted for such purposes
- To carry out our obligations arising from any contracts entered into between you and us
- To notify you about changes to our club, its membership or the services it provides and the events that it promotes
- Where any relevant medical conditions, physical or mental impairments are disclosed to ensure, in consultation with you, that these factors are taken in to consideration in relation to the swimmers training and other activities within the club. All such data shall be treated as sensitive data
